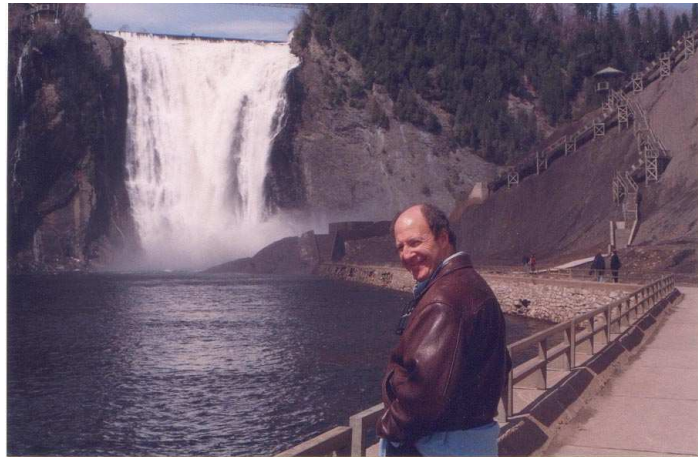
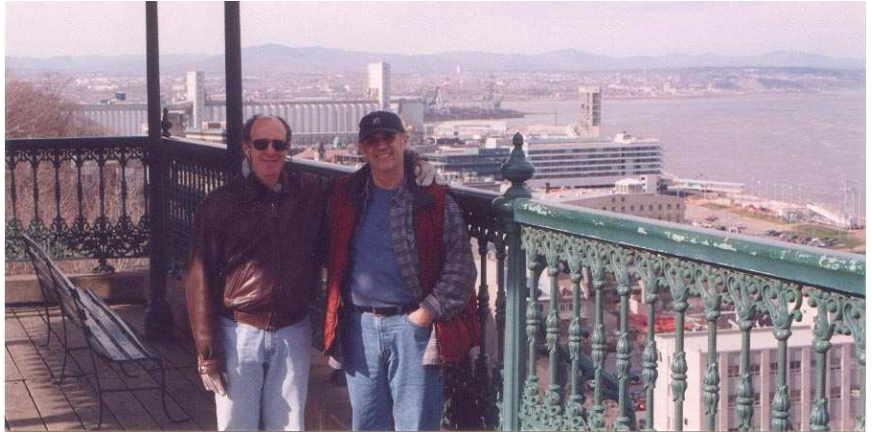
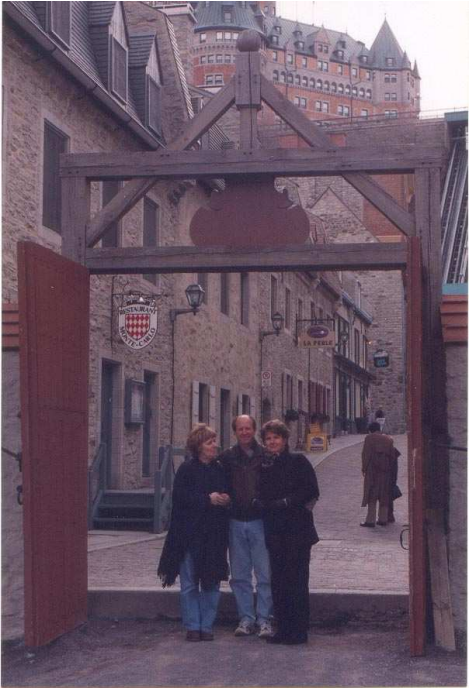


## PHOTO GALLERY
